- Ocean Shores Golf Course - the course beckons players of all skill levels to come and enjoy a varying field.
- Damon Point - With four miles of beach walking and water on three sides, Damon Point is one of the best places to hike and view wildlife in the North Beach area.
- Razor Clam Digging - You don't need any prior experience for this activity; everyone from little ones to grandparents can enjoy this activity.
- Electric Biking - they are a lot of fun and really easy to ride. The pedal assist and throttle make it really easy to pedal down the beach.
- Rent an Electric Boat - Choose the equipment you wish to explore the 23 miles of fresh waterways - the hidden gem of Ocean Shores.



- Fishing - The offshore waters and bountiful lakes and rivers provide plenty of great fishing opportunities. You can try your hand at freshwater fishing, or hire an outfitter to take you out for deep sea adventures..
- Kite Flying - When you have miles of drivable coastline, a wonderful breeze blowing in, and all the amenities to be a family friendly destination, of course, Ocean Shores is the place to go fly a kite!
- Horseback Riding on the Beach - the horses go at a gentle pace while experienced guides point out the Pacific Ocean's wildlife.
