- Denver (city) population = 699,288
- Denver (metro) population = 2,931,000
- There are 200 named peaks visible from Denver.
- Denver is exactly one mile high above sea level.
- Within a mile radius, downtown Denver has three major sports stadiums, the nation's second-largest performing arts center, three colleges, an assortment of art museums, history museums, and restaurants.
- Denver has 300 days of sunshine a year!
- There are more than 200 parks within the city and 20,000 acres of parks in the nearby foothills!
- Denver's live music scene entertains yearround, ranging from intimate venues like the Paramount Theatre to legendary open-air spots like Red Rocks Park & Amphitheatre.
- Denver was founded in 1858 as a mining town during the peak of the Gold Rush era.

Denver • Things to Do

There are so many ways to explore Denver!

These are some of the most popular things to do around town.

City Life

- Larimer Square Victorian buildings house specialty boutiques and unique chef-driven restaurants.
- LoDo (Historic District) Filled with turn-of-thecentury warehouses, now home to 90 brewpubs, sports bars, restaurants, and rooftop cafes.
- Union Station This Beaux-Arts 1914 train terminal is now a foodie destination and an entertainment hub, with a dozen restaurants, bars, shops, and hotel.

Art Life

- Denver Art Museum The building was designed by Italian architect Gio Ponti and Denver-based James Sudler Associates. The museum showcases Asian art, Indigenous arts of North America, Northwest Coast, and Alaska Native, European and American art before 1900, and Latin American.
- Meow Wolf Denver Discover immersive, mindbending art across the four alien worlds of C Street, Eemia, Ossuary and Numina.
- The Blue Bear "I See What You Mean," AKA the giant Blue Bear stands 40 feet tall Created by Colorado-based artist Lawrence Argent

Outdoor Life

- Confluence Park Denver was founded at Confluence Park as a gold mining camp in 1858.
 Today, the river park is the heart of Denver's bike trail network and is surrounded by attractions.
- City Park Denver's largest park, has several lakes, spectacular mountain views, a public golf course, flower gardens, and a hiking/jogging trail that is exactly one mile high.
- Wash Park The long, rectangular park has two lakes, paddle boat rentals, bike rentals, shade trees, a two-mile jogging path, mountain views and a huge area for volleyball tournaments.
- Denver Botanic Gardens -A 23-acre oasis in the middle of the city.

Did you know there are loans that are specifically curated for physicians?

Loan Overview:

- •100% Financing available for certain loan amounts No Money Down!
- -Minimum 2 of your 3 credit scores must be 700 or above
- to do 100% financing
- -680-699 must put 5% down
- -100% financing from \$100,000 to \$750,000
- -\$750,000 to \$1,250,000 requires 5% down
- -\$1,250,000 to \$2,000,000 requires 10% down
- •90-95% for rate and term refinance (Cash out is not allowed)
- •No PMI = Lower Payments
- •Move in even before you start your job! (Can close 60 days out with reserves, further out on a case-by-case basis with additional reserves)
- •Generous Debt Ratio Allowance of up to 50%
- Seller Paid Closing Costs Allowed
- -3% for 90-100% financing
- -Up to 6% when putting more than 10% down
- •Minimal reserves required (2 months PITI if you're working and additional required if you'd not started your job)
- -Loans of \$500,000 and above require a minimum of 6 months of reserves
- •All borrowers must have a minimum of 3 credit references to qualify or one if you've had a mortgage or can prove 12 months' rents payments
- •Minimum loan amount is \$100,000
- •If you are a non-permanent resident alien, you must have 2 years of US credit history
- Condos must be "warrantable" for 100% financing.
- -"Non-warrantable" condos require 10% down

It is *imperative* you talk to a mortgage professional. Remember: your application is unique to *YOU!*
