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

- Savannah attracts many Hollywood movie productions and you can see filming throughout the year in different spots in the city


WHAT'S AROUND SAVANNAH




POOLER

THE ISLANDS


Wonderful waterfront neighborhoods, shopping areas that are walking distance from most homes, and excellent access to inshore waters for family fun!









- Forsyth Park - One of the reasons Savannah is so loved is all our parks. Check out a festival, a race, or just hang out and have a picnic in this huge grassy park with our famous fountain.
