





BIGHORN TAVERN

Damonte Ranch: Southeast Reno is home to Damonte (pronounced Duh mon tee) Ranch, a vibrant community with select gated enclaves that has quickly become a sought-after place to live. Adjacent to The Summit shopping center and the efficient Veterans Parkway, residents enjoy swift access to Sparks, I-80, and the scenic drive to Mt. Rose Ski Resort and Lake Tahoe. For those with a commute to Carson City, Damonte Ranch is not just a home but a strategic choice for a balanced life.

Midtown: The heart of Reno's history beats in Midtown, where homes from the 1930s to 1950s stand with timeless charm. 3 FERNLEY


Traffic flow in and out of Fernley can quickly become a challenge, particularly when incidents occur on I-80. Given that I-80 is a primary artery running east and west from Sparks, and with only two entrance points into Fernley=including Alt Hwy 50 and Hwy 50 from the east-any accidents on this interstate can lead to significant backups. The limited ingress and egress options from Reno/Sparks mean that residents and visitors alike must be prepared for potential delays especially if you are commuting from Reno/Sparks.





HIKING

Most Popular Hiking Trails Near Reno:

Check out Whites Creek, Upper Thomas Creek and Dry pond to find beautiful views, creeks and pine trees. They are gorgeous hikes in the woods and are recommended when there isn't snow unless you bring your snow shoes. Davis Creek Campground and Little Washoe Trail are in the Valley and are nice places to go in the colder months.





Emerald Bay:

Emerald Bay will absolutely take your breath away. You can park in the designated area of Emerald Bay State Park along Hwy 89 and hike over to the waterfall right near the highway and also down to Vikinsgholm (A one mile paved trail). It is a 38 room mansion that was completed in 1929. There are tours offered from Memorial Day to the end of September.

Angora Lakes:

Angora Lake is above Fallen Leaf Lake. Follow Angora Ridge Rd. Then hike the rugged trail that is located 1/2 mile above the parking lot. Open mid June - Sept. Parking is \$10. There are nine small cabins available for a weekly rentals.

You can buy fresh squeezed lemonade, sandwiches, ice cream and row boat, SUP and kayak rentals at upper Angora Lake. Cash is preferred.

Chickadee Ridge:

This is an easy hike located just off of Hwy 431 and about 6.5 miles after the roundabout in Incline Village. Get there early as parking gets congested along the meadow. You'll see a beautiful view of the lake on the hike and in the late winter months and very early into spring you'll see the chickadees in the tree lines. If you put your hand out with birdseed, they will land right on it.



PADDLE BOARDING

Explore Paddle Boarding Around Tahoe:

In my experience, the most breathtaking places to paddleboard on Lake Tahoe include Sand Harbor, the stretch from Speedboat Beach to Kings Beach, and Emerald Bay. The beauty of the crystal-clear waters, granite boulders, pine trees, and the soothing sound of water lapping against your paddleboard is unparalleled.







