Your Moving Checklist

UPON RECEIVING YOUR ORDERS TO SAN DIEGO

STEP 1: RECEIVE ORDERS

FOUR WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR MOVE

- Schedule Movers
- Start to sort, donate and discard items
- Inform schools of transfer (current and future)
- Eat perishable foods to avoid waste
- Contact Insurance to change coverages
 - Car Insurance
 - Homeowners Insurance
- File address change with:
 - CreditCard Companies
 - Subscriptions
 - Clubs
 - Memberships
 - Associations

THREE WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR MOVE

- Start packing
- Complete a post office address change, and send new address to friends and family
- Make necessary travel arrangements including interim housing, car rental
 - Don't forget to record confirmation numbers!
- Collect medical records and prescriptions from doctors and health professionals
- Dispose of items that can't move with you (propane, flammables, etc.)
- Place legal, medical and insurance papers in an accessible place (write down where they are in your phone!)
- Let other professionals you are working with know you are moving
 - Accountant
 - Attorney
 - Schools
 - Medical Professionals
 - Spouses workplace
 - Gardener, cleaning company
 - Kid's tutors and sports teams

TWO WEEKS PRIOR TO YOUR MOVE

- Arrange to disconnect utilities
 - Electric and Gas
 - Water/Sewer/Trash
 - Phone
 - Cable
 - Internet
 - Other _____
- Take pets to vet for immunization and ask for animal moving advice
- Return borrowed items
- Change your address with the DMV



Your Moving Checklist

ONE WEEK PRIOR TO YOUR MOVE

- Prepare car (if you're driving)
 - Oil change
 - Brake Check
 - Fluid Check
- Drain water from household hoses
- Drain gasoline and oil from any lawn mower or power equipment
- Pick up items sent to cleaners or for repairs
- Pay any outstanding bills

FINAL DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR MOVE

- Defrost and Clean out refrigerator
- Pack luggage separately for what you will need in your first days. Label: "Load Last"
- Reconfirm travel arrangements
- Reserve parking space for movers and make sure the path is clear

MOVING DAY

- Be available for questions
- Go over inventory with Driver
- Point out ALL fragile items
- Triple check if anything is left behind!
- Do not leave until the movers are gone
- Keep Cash to Tip workers

Frequently Asked Questions

Q What are the benefits of a VA Loan?

A No Down Payment Required:

One of the most significant advantages of a VA loan is that you can purchase a home without having to make a down payment. This feature sets VA loans apart from many other types of mortgages where a substantial down payment is typically required.

Competitive Interest Rates: VA loans often offer competitive interest rates. The U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs guarantees a portion of the loan, which reduces the risk for lenders. This guarantee makes lenders more willing to offer favorable terms, including lower Interest rates which can result in lower monthly mortgage payments, saving you money over the life of the loan.

Limited Closing Costs: VA loans come with limitations on the types and amount of closing costs that veterans are allowed to pay. In some cases, the seller can cover some or all of the closing costs. This can help reduce the financial burden on the veteran during the homebuying process.

Q How much will I need to Purchase a home?

A Even though VA loans limit the types and amounts of closing costs that veterans can pay, there are some costs associated with the home purchase. These can include items like appraisal fees, credit report fees, title insurance, escrow fees and other closing-related expenses. In some cases, the seller may contribute to or cover these costs. We have helped veterans purchase homes with as little as \$500 out of pocket when the seller agreed to pay for most closing costs. However, It is prudent to plan for and set aside about 2-3% of the purchase price to cover closing costs.

Q How long does it take to purchase a home in San Diego?

A A typical close of escrow (celebration day) is 30 days after your offer is accepted. However, the escrow period can be as little as 14 days or as long as 60 days after your offer is accepted.



Frequently Asked Questions

Q When will I get the keys to my new home?

A You will receive the keys to your home on the day of close of escrow. If you are not in the area, your agent will receive your keys and hold them until you arrive in the area.

Q What happens when we find our ideal home?

A Once you have found your ideal home, your agent will begin the process of submitting an offer. This starts with your agent negotiating price and terms for the purchase. Next your agent will draft the purchase agreement and then review the details with you. When you are comfortable, your agent will send the agreement to you for signatures.

Q How soon should I start looking for my new home?

A You'll want to reach out to us as soon as you receive orders to set up a home search. Purchasing a home is a learning experience and we are here to educate and guide you through every step of the process.

Q Do I need to be present to purchase a home?

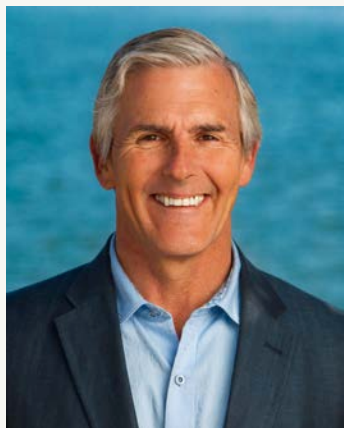
A No, with modern technology you will be able to complete the process and review/sign documents on line. You will need to sign loan and escrow documents with a Notary. If you are stateside, the notary can come to you. If you are overseas, plan to visit the embassy to have documents notarized.
