MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS

Tennessee's motor vehicle laws may have some differences compared to other states, although many regulations are similar across the United States.

Slowpoke Law: Tennessee has a "slowpoke law" that requires drivers to keep right except when passing on highways with two or more lanes traveling in the same direction. This law is designed to keep traffic flowing smoothly.

Motorcycle Helmet Laws: Tennessee requires all motorcycle riders and passengers to wear helmets while the motorcycle is in motion, regardless of age or experience level.

Vehicle Inspections: Tennessee does not require regular vehicle safety inspections for passenger vehicles, unlike some states that mandate annual or biennial inspections. However, emissions testing is required in certain counties, including Davidson, Hamilton, Rutherford, Sumner, Williamson, and Wilson.

Child Passenger Safety Laws: Tennessee requires children under the age of 8 and under 4'9" in height to ride in a child restraint system appropriate for their age, weight, and height. This may include car seats, booster seats, or seat belts, depending on the child's size.

Cell Phone Use: Tennessee prohibits texting while driving for all drivers. Additionally, novice drivers (those with learner's permits or intermediate licenses) are banned from using handheld cell phones while driving.

Open Container Laws: Tennessee has strict open container laws prohibiting the possession or consumption of alcoholic beverages in the passenger area of a motor vehicle. This applies to both drivers and passengers.

Vehicle Registration and Driver's License: Upon moving to Tennessee, you must register your vehicle and obtain a Tennessee driver's license within a certain period (usually 30 days) of establishing residency.
